The uniform cannot be modified, worn or used for activities other than those authorized by the commanding officer of 338 Royal Canadian Air Cadet Squadron.

I acknowledge that the uniform is the property of the Canadian Cadet Organization represented by the staff of 338 Junior Wildcats Brossard Optimist squadron and that the different articles have been lent, free of charge, to my child / pupil for the duration of his membership with 338 Junior Wildcats Brossard Optimist squadron.

I have been informed that all articles that have been lent to my child/ pupil have a total value of more than \$500 and that I will have to ensure that the uniform is properly maintained and worn in accordance with the cadet dress regulations provided to my child / pupil. Uniform parts that becomes too small as the cadet grows up will be exchanged at no cost upon presentation of the uniform parts at the cadet unit headquarter.

I also understand that as a parent/guardian, I must return within 10 days all uniform parts lent to my child since his/her registration should he/she decide to quit the cadet program. I understand that if the uniform is not turned to the squadron head quarter within 10 days after the termination of cadet membership, I will be invoiced the sum of \$500 for the total value of the uniform lent to my child.
